SIXTY-TWO BAPTISMS for the first six months of 1931. Such is the report for the Malayan Union. The consecrated toil which lies back of these figures cannot be indicated by any device we know of. We all rejoice in this evidence of genuine progress in this difficult and needy field. The net gain in membership for the six months' period is 33.

A GAIN IN SABBATH SCHOOL OFFERINGS of \$156.47 for the second quarter! Some of this gain is accounted for by the fact that the returns for the first quarter were not as complete as those for the second, so we cannot expect a corresponding increase for the third quarter unless there is a strong effort on the part of each member to that end.

A DECREASE IN TITHE for the quarter has had to be recorded. Judging by the amount paid per capita, there is surely room for an increase, in spite of decreased wages and general financial conditions. Let us encourage each member by precept and by example, to realize his privileges as a steward of God.

SPLENDID GAIN IN LITERATURE SALES! During the second quarter we sold nearly two thousand dollars' worth of literature more than the quarter before. This is largely due to Brother Werner's vigorous work in the field and the loyal support of the local mission officers and church members during the Big Week. We are still \$2,500 below the sales for the second quarter of 1930, but rapid progress is being made along right lines.

GOOD CHEER FROM THE FIELD

Pastor Abel sends in a most encouraging account of the public effort in Ubol. The chapel is filled, more than one hundred persons attending regularly, including a number of teachers, judges and government officials. A hunger for the Truth is manifested on the part of the people there. Let us join Brother Abel in prayer for the salvation of many souls in East Siam.

Pastor Youngberg is busy locating on the Tatau river, and will soon be moving his family there. He plans to erect a bungalow, dispensary, and reception house on the mission property. Brother Sinaga will be located farther upriver in one of the Dyak villages. A house will be built for him there. Brother Smith has been in Kuching during most of July, overseeing the preparation of a small boat for Brother Youngberg's use. It should be ready the latter part of August.

The Penang sanitarium has now a number of patients, and the Clinic is enjoying excellent patronage.
