# The Statistical Report for 1924

## A REPORT SHOWING SIXTY-TWO YEARS OF PROGRESS

In the following pages will be found the sixty-second annual statistical report of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination, for the year 1924. In the case of certain organizations noted in Table 2, the figures for the former year have been inserted because of non-receipt of returns for 1924.

### Extent of Work

This work is now conducted in 119 countries, by 8 Division Conferences, 52 Union organizations, comprising 138 local conferences, and 164 mission fields, operating among a population aggregating 1,804,982,487 and employing 16,405 evangelistic and institutional laborers, who are using in their work 224 languages (publications being issued in 114), and connected with the movement are 248 institutions, representing, together with conference organizations and 1,957 church buildings, a total investment (for 1923) of \$40,675,238.72, and an aggregate annual income for both evangelistic and institutional work, of \$29,367,742.12.

### Churches and Members

The number of organized churches now stands at 5,393 an increase of 297 during 1924. The membership of churches now stands at 238,657, an increase during 1924, of 16,783, the largest in the history of this movement. The annual gain in members during recent years has been as follows:

 (a) This system of educational work outlined by the Educational Department of the General Conference in 1900, comprising sixteen grades, or years of study, is arranged as follows: Church-schools (information concerning which will be found listed under columns 22 to 26 in Table 1), grades 1-9; intermediate schools, grades 7-10; academies, grades 9-12; colleges, grades 13-16.

(b) In compiling the returns, fractions of acres were not included.

(c) The "capacity" of schools is the number of students that may be accommodated in classes, and

does not refer to dormitory or boarding accommodations provided.

(d) The grades taught by each should indicate the kind of work undertaken, as outlined in note (a).

(f) In the column indicating laboratory facilities the word "No" occurs where the schools have none; the word "Yes" is used in connection with schools having such facilities. These facilities cover lines of work in various schools as follows: Astronomy, chemistry, physics, histology, zoology.

Schools having facilities for manual training are indicated by "Yes" in corresponding column;

those not having such facilities are listed with "No" opposite. These facilities range as follows: Carpentry, cooking, farming, dairying, nursing, printing, plumbing, horticulture, dressmaking, tent-making, broom-making, brick-making, etc.

(g) Column 14 shows the total number of graduates from all grades; cols. 15, 16, and 17, the number graduated from grades 12, 14, and 16, respectively.

(h) Column 18 shows the number of students (not graduates alone) entering some department of denominational work during the year.

**Denominational Literature**

The sale of denominational literature during 1924 aggregated \$4,236,120.09. This literature, issued in 114 languages, is prepared (see Table 3, page 16) in the form of 156 periodicals, 1,016 bound books, 672 pamphlets, 2,469 tracts, a total of 4,313 separate publications (containing 348,882 pages), one copy of each of which (books in cloth binding) is valued at \$1,301.68.

The total retail value of denominational literature circulated since the organization of this work is \$59,999,461.70,—indicated by decades as follows:

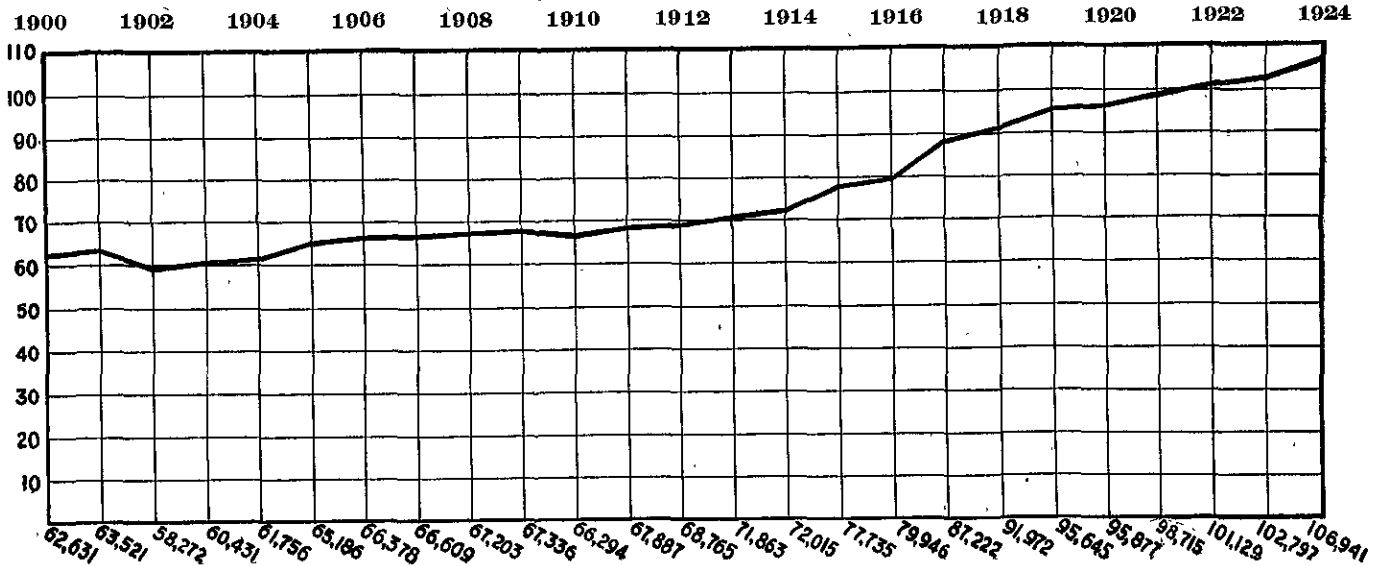

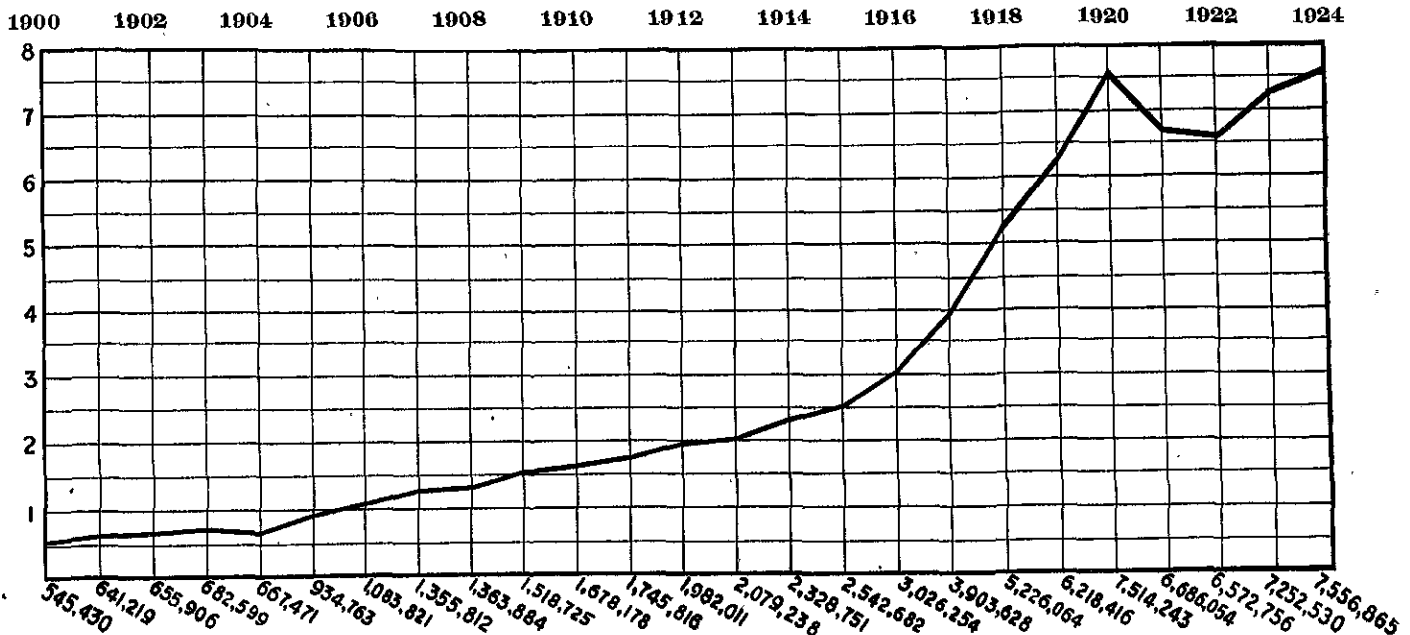
### Membership in United States and Canada—1900 to 1924
