The Statistical Report for 1928

A REPORT SHOWING SIXTY-SIX YEARS OF PROGRESS

The following pages present the sixty-sixth annual Statistical Report of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination, for the year 1928.

Extent of Work

This work is now conducted in 135 countries, by eight division and 65 union organizations, comprising 153 local conferences, 222 mission fields, operating among a population aggregating 1,800,000,000, and employing 18,866 evangelistic and institutional laborers, who are using in their work 347 languages, and connected with the movement are 328 institutions, representing, together with conference organizations and 2,622 church buildings, a total investment (for 1927—the latest available) of \$49,293,887.27, a per capita of \$179.86, and an aggregate annual income for both evangelistic and institutional work (for 1927) of \$41,018,692.33, a per capita income of \$149.67.

Membership

At the close of 1928, the membership of the 6,227 organized churches stood at 285,293, a net increase during 1928 of 11,229; the increase for 1927 was 12,230; for 1926, 10,346, and for 1925, 12,331; a total increase for the past four years of 46,636, or 19.54 per cent.

In 1916 the membership of the entire denomination was 141,488, the gain from that time to the close of 1928 was 143,805, the per cent of increase being 101.64. That is, during the past twelve years since 1916, the membership of the denomination has more than doubled, or for every 100 members in 1916, there are now 201.64 members.

Taking it another way: The gain in membership during the past twelve years was 2,317 more than during the preceding 54 years.

The average efficiency of each member in making contributions has increased in like manner; for in 1916, the average contributions for solely evangelistic work averaged \$27.92, while in 1928, the average was \$43.01. In other words, for every \$100 given by each member in 1916, each member now contributes \$154.05 for purposes of evangelistic work.

Counting by decades from the organization of this movement, the per capita of total funds has run as follows:

Educational Work

The denomination is conducting schools of all kinds numbering 1,523, with total student enrolment of 61,774, employing 3,715 teachers. The investment in these schools is \$8,834,654.86. The average number of students per teacher is 16.63, and there is one student for every 4.62 members in the denomination. In other words, the student body comprises 21.65 per cent of the total membership of the denomination.

Publishing Work

There are 56 publishing houses and branches, whose assets (for 1927) aggregated \$3,851,659.86, employing 1,057 persons in the production of literature. There are 2,621 other persons engaged in its circulation, making a total of 3,678 persons employed in connection with literature work.

This literature is issued in 141 languages in the form of 215 periodicals; 1,333 bound books; 825 pamphlets; 3,330 tracts, a total of 5,703 publications (containing 433,016 pages), one copy of each being valued at \$1,700.68.

The sale of denominational literature for 1928 aggregated \$4,716,601.54, and the total value of sales since the organization of this movement is \$78,817,328.32, indicated by decades as follows:

Sanitariums

Connected with denominational activities there are 30 sanitariums, 51 treatment rooms, employing 474 physicians, 3,315 nurses and others, making a total of 3,789 engaged in the care of sick and suffering. The investment in buildings and equipment for such care (for 1927) was \$7,318,624.16.

Languages

In addition to the 141 languages in which publications are issued, this work is now conducted orally by denominational representatives in 206 other languages, a total of 347 languages in which this work is now being carried forward. This is an increase of 68 languages during 1928, or one new language added every 5.88 days. At the close of 1924, this work was conducted in 224 languages so that there has been an increase of 123 languages during the past four years, or a new language added practically every twelve days during the past four years.

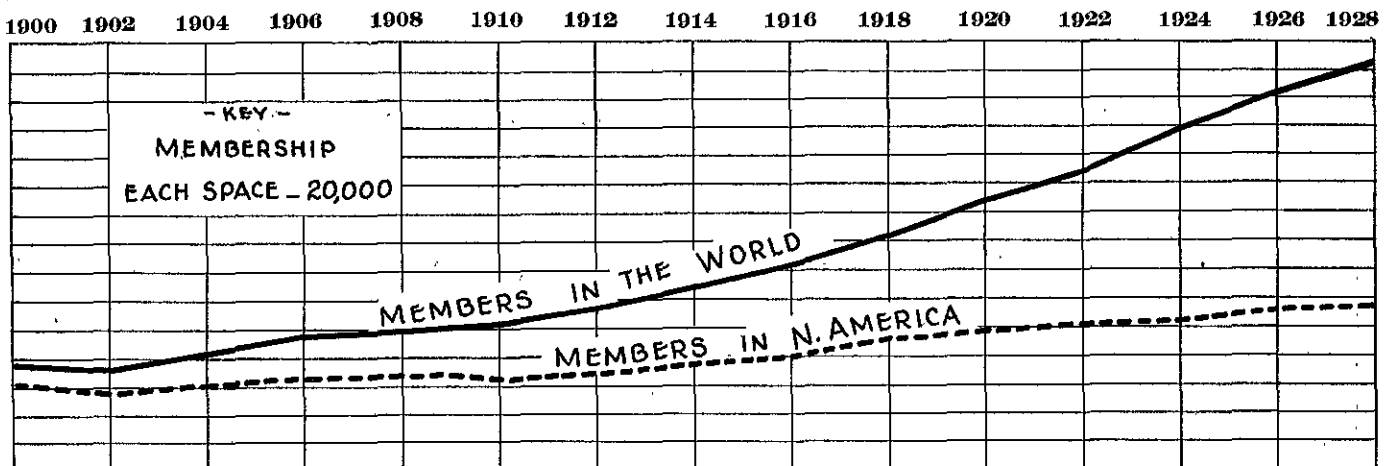
Laborers

There are employed by the denomination in evangelistic lines of work, 9,765; connected with institutions there are 9,101, a total of 18,866 evangelistic and institutional laborers. This number constitutes one laborer for every 15.12 members.

The total number of laborers in North America is 7,999; outside this country, 10,867, the proportion being for every 100 laborers in North America, there are 135.85 outside this country.

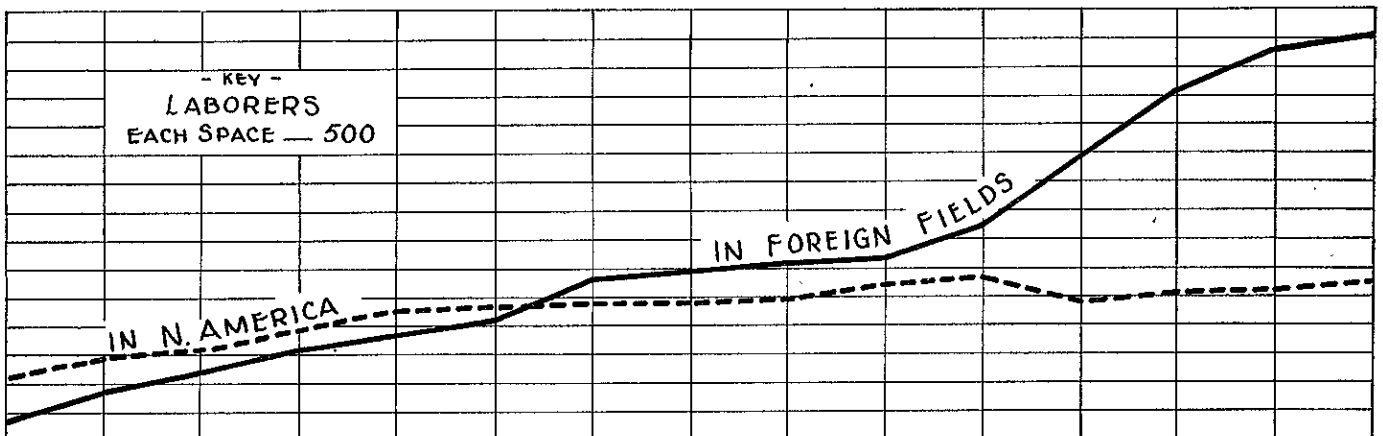

Funds

The total amount of tithes and offerings received for all lines of evangelistic work during 1928 was \$12,271,753.60, an increase over the amount received during the preceding year of \$326,938.58, or 2.74 per cent. This amount is a per capita of \$43.01 for each of the 285,293 members throughout the world; the per capita for the 113,737 members in North America was \$75.53, and for the 171,556 members in all other countries, \$21.46.

The total funds received for 1928 may be classified as follows: Tithes \$6,373,147.36, an increase over the preceding year of \$161,388.16, or 2.60 per cent; foreign mission offering \$3,881,879.95, an increase over the receipts for the preceding year of \$110,991.66, or 2.94 per cent; for home missions \$2,016,726.29, an increase over the receipts for the preceding year of \$54,558.76, or 2.78 per cent.

The total amount of tithes and offerings received since the beginning of this movement up to the close of 1928, aggregates \$154,611,837.43, of which tithe was \$87,979,218.00 (56.90 per cent); foreign mission offerings \$43,545,586.60 (28.17 per cent) and home mission offerings \$23,087,032.83 (14.93 per cent). The amount received from North America was \$114,355,848.12 (73.96 per cent), and from all other countries, \$40,255,989.31 (26.04 per cent).

As previously stated, the total funds received for all evangelistic lines of work during the sixty-six years since this movement was organized, has been \$154,611,837.43, of which amount \$83,131,294.37 was received during the eight years since 1921, leaving \$71,480,543.06 as the amount received during the first fifty-eight years after this work was organized. In other words, for every \$100 received during the first fifty-eight years after the organization of this movement, (1863-1920) there was received during the past eight years, \$116.30.

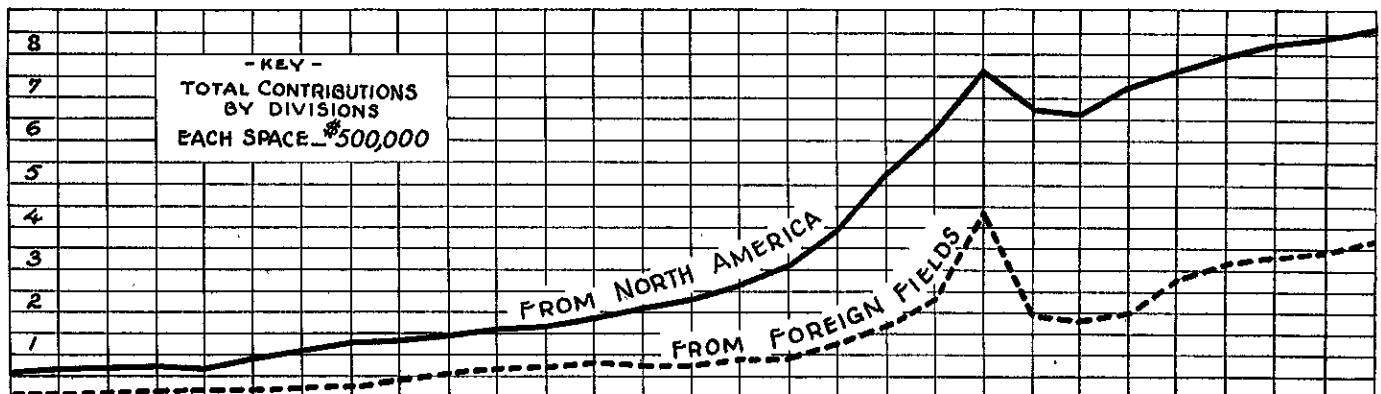

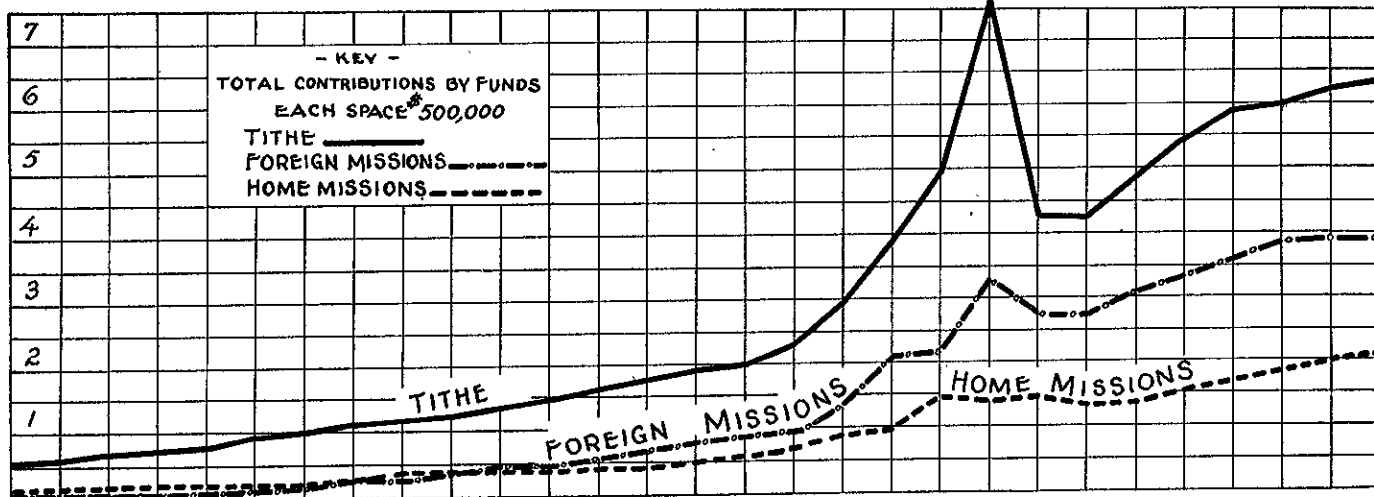
