TO REVIEW AND HERALD

VOTED, To accept and implement the following report submitted by the President's Administrative Council, to become effective September 1, 1974:

May 30, 1974

(Print Shop Transfer - contd)

1. Rationale for Transferring General Conference Printing to Review and Herald

- a. The Review and Herald specializes in printing.
- b. The Review and Herald administration indicates an interest in accepting General Conference printing jobs and will organize a separate job printing service to meet General Conference needs for job printing as well as its own in-house needs in that category.
- c. The General Conference will in this way divest itself of the printing operation and assign its printing to a publishing house in harmony with denominational policy.
- d. The discontinuance of the printing operation in the General Conference will release space for other purposes.
- e. The Review and Herald administration has given assurances that a job printing service will be organized that will be responsive to the needs of the General Conference.

2. Transfer of Personnel

The Review and Herald administration has agreed it will employ all available General Conference print shop personnel with the exception of those serving in the duplicating (mimeograph/ITEK) section. (See #6 below).

3. Financial Implications

The Review and Herald administration has calculated that the actual job cost will be no more than currently. However, job charges will probably be higher reflecting more accurately the true cost. This committee does not have information to determine precisely the extent of such additional charges nor their effect on departmental budgets. Therefore estimates of possible pricing changes are to be developed by a committee involving the present General Conference print shop manager and the Review and Herald superintendent. The General Conference Treasury and the Review and Herald administration are then requested to determine the total increase in charges and how these may be absorbed.

4. Transfer of Equipment and Supplies

The transfer of equipment will be made at a nominal figure (residual book value) to be mutually agreed upon by the Review and Herald and the General Conference. Supplies will be transferred at cost.

5. Relationships between General Conference and Review and Herald for General Conference Printing

The General Conference Printing Committee will continue to supervise all General Conference printing and route all jobs as at present. Job authorizations will continue to be processed through an assistant treasurer. The Review and Herald administration has agreed it will assign an individual to service all General Conference printing jobs.

6. Duplicating Facilities

The General Conference will continue to service its own needs for mimeograph and ITEK duplication.

7. Extent of Transfer

General Conference printing currently being assigned to the General Conference print shop will be assigned by the same criteria to the Review and Herald job printing service.
