Schools are evangelizing agencies as has been demonstrated by the teachers and students of Mountain View College, Philippines. During 1974, 15 churches were organized and 1,134 people baptized in the vicinity of the College.

W J Brown also mentioned the educational institutions that have moved, plans for future relocations, and affiliations of overseas colleges with North American colleges and universities.

MINUTES of the meeting held February 20, 1975, were approved.
