DEVOTIONAL MESSAGE

Enoch Oliveira reported comments have been made that the Church in North America appears to be failing. Although the rate of growth is down, statistics in Religion in America for the periods of 1955-1966 and 1966-1975 indicate that while many prominent churches are suffering a decline in membership, the Seventh-day Adventist Church has had a growth rate of 31.5% and 36% during these two periods.

On the request of the Chair, comments were made on why church growth has slowed and how membership could grow faster. Replies were as follows: an affluent life-style tends to deaden the hope/desire for heaven and leads to decreased evangelistic fervor, loss of the sense of uniqueness of the Seventh-day Adventist Church results in a lack of personal response, many Adventist homes have become very troubled places, there is need for Bible preaching for there is power in the message God has given this Church.

In closing, the Chairman listed four ways in which church growth could be accelerated in North America: fostering unity among the churches, crystallizing the concept that every minister is an evangelist, adopting a more conservative theology with strength of conviction, involving all believers in the mission of the church. If we work under the operation of the Holy Spirit we will see remarkable results in our day.
