He visited Bugema Adventist College about 20 miles from Kampala. Just prior to his visit, bandits had entered the College. As usual under such circumstances, faculty and students had taken refuge in the surrounding bush. The acting president of the College introduced the visitors and told of the many times he had fled to the bush for protection. Under these extremely trying conditions, he learned that the opposite of love is not hatred: it is indifference. The Chairman pointed out that the sin of Laodicea is indifference. There is need to guard against indifference in our work, our stewardship and in the use of time. In closing he stated, "May God guide us that we may be filled wth energy and enthusiasm to fulfill the role He has given us."
