

Final Report of the Committee on Education.

The Committee on Education beg leave to report, as their final recommendation, the following preamble and resolution:-

Whereas, We were told many years ago that the cause of God needed more ministers and Bible workers; that there was a dearth of well qualified laborers in these departments of the work; that cultivated intellect was even then needed in the cause, for novices could not do the work acceptably; that God had devised the only college we then had as an instrumentality for developing workers of <sup>whom</sup> ~~which~~ he would not be ashamed,

and that if the <sup>2</sup> latent talents  
then in the church could have  
been developed and brought  
into use we would have had turn-  
ty ministers where we <sup>there</sup> had one, and-

Whereas, This instruction  
is applicable, with even greater  
force, to our present conditions,  
and men, <sup>whom God has called</sup> seem to be turn-  
ing away from the sacred  
<sup>work</sup> calling of the ministry to en-  
gage in other pursuits, therefor-
