AID FOR MIDDLE EAST COLLEGE EXPENSE FOR SHUKRI NOWFEL 2835 The Middle East College board has found that it is possible to arrange for the Arabic teaching at the college without the help of Elder Shukri Nowfel, who has expressed to several that he is tired of teaching, therefore, with the understanding that unpaid college debts will be deducted from his monthly payments, it was
