IRAQ SECTION CALL VOTED, To pass on to the Egypt Section the call from the Iraq Section for Samir Dawood to serve as a Bible instructor FOR SAMIR DAWOOD 66/79 with the understanding that he plan to enter middle East College in the future, on his own responsibility, to continue his education.

SAMIR DAWOOD SALARY RATE 66/80

VOTED, To set the salary rate for Samir Dawood at 40 per cent of the ordained minister's salary in Iraq.

<u>VOTED</u>, To ask Harand Melikian to assist with the Division transportation work for the summer months and that he also be available to do Division maintenance or any other work as arranged when he is not doing transportation work. His salary is to be LL 300.00 per month.

<u>VOTED</u>, To approve the sale to Middle East College for a sum of LL 900.00 the Olivetti calculator that has been in the treasurer's office.

VOTED, To accept the recommendation of the Middle East College Board granting a leave of absence to Dr. Joseph Khoury, beginning July 1, 1966 and ending June 30, 1967.

VOTED, To add the following sentence to the Medical Expense Policy, par. 1, p. 98 of the Middle East Division <u>Working</u> Policy.

"Assistance as provided for above may also apply on the expense of medical and orthopedic appliances when prescribed by a qualified physician."

<u>VOTED</u>, To revise the first part of par. 45, p. 141 of the Middle East Division <u>Working</u> Policy, Medical Expense for Sustentees, to read as follows:

"A beneficiary having medical and/or dental and/or optical and/or hearing aid expense may receive assistance on such expense in an amount equivalent to three-fourths of such expense."

<u>VOTED</u>, To accept the recommendation of the Middle East College Board that Dr. Kenneth Vine and Dr. S. J. Schwantes join the SDA archaeological team under the direction of Dr. Siegfried Horn of Andrews University. This team is to conduct an excavation in the summer of 1967.

BENGHAZI PHYSICIANS <u>VOTED</u>, To set the travel budget for physicians at the <u>TRAVEL BUDGET</u> Benghazi Hospital at 14,000 kilometers a year.

WHEREAS, The Division committee in 1961 organized the Religious Research project naming Elder Kobert Darnell as its executive secretary to pursue a religious research project in the area of Islam and to select, prepare, and make ready for use literature, Bible lessons, books, manuals, and other necessary means for working among non-Christians;

WHEREAS, Elder Darnell has felt a special burden and possesses unusual capabilities and talents in the field of Eastern languages and religious backgrounds, and has had long years of mission experience, and

WHEREAS, Elder Darnell at present is studying at the University of Michigan and has presented to the committee his desire for guidance in his future study program toward a doctorate in Eastern Studies, it was

<u>VOTED</u>, To recommend to the General Conference for approval that Robert Darnell be granted time to continue his present study program in order that he might complete a doctorate in Eastern Studies at the University of Michigan, with the possibility that the time required could extend to the summer of 1968, it being understood that he would return to the Middle East Division to take up the work of the Religious Research Department as his primary responsibility.

IRAN SECTION INCOME TAX AND UTILITY ALLOWANCE 66/101 <u>VOTED</u>, To approve the request of the Iran Section to implement Actions 66/46 and 66/67 regarding assistance on utility allowance and income tax retroactive to Jan. 1, 1966. The treasurer has been informed that there are sufficient funds to cover this added expense.

IRAN SECTION ELEMENTARY SCHOOL LAND PURCHASE 66/102 WHEREAS, The Iran Section is in need of property for the proposed elementary school in Tehran;

WHEREAS, The land adjoining the present mission headquarters is up for sale and meets the need of the proposed school, and

WHEREAS, The Iran Section is to benefit from the Second Quarter Thirteenth Sabbath Overflow Offering for this project, it was

<u>VOTED</u>, To approve in principle the request of the Iran Section to investigate the possibilities of purchasing the property in question and that they have written government permission to operate the school before final settlement is made. It is understood that the land will cost Rials 7,000,000.

"To authorize Anees Haddad to attend Andrews University to complete a Master's degree in the field of Behavioral Sciences under the provisions of the Policy for Advanced Study by Workers of the Middle East Division. Elder Haddad is a delegate to the General Conference and will begin study immediately following the session. He will leave the Middle East Division May 29."
