NEW YORK WORLD'S FAIR, 1964-1965:

Further consideration was given to plans for participation in the New York World's Fair, 1964-1965. It is felt that it would be wiser planning to provide small disks for distribution, rather than a large number of leaflets.

- VOTED, 1. To authorize the Treasurer to sign a contract, leasing 500 square feet in the Protestant Building for the 1964-1965 New York World's Fair.
- 2. That we proceed with plans to order 500,000 "Look 'n Listen" Laminated Paper Records at the quoted price of .031 cents each, or a total cost of \$15,000, as a public relations gesture of the Seventh-day Adventists, for distribution at the New York World's Fair; these records to be 33 RPM, with two-color printing on both sides of the disk.
- 3. That we suggest to our three major publishing houses that they sponsor an advertisement on the reverse side of the disk at a cost of \$7,000 to the Review and Herald, \$7,000 to the Pacific Press, and \$2,000 to the Southern Publishing Association.
