ATLANTIC UNION CONFERENCE REVOLVING LOAN FUND POLICY

VOTED to recommend approval of the following guidelines in the establishment of a Revolving Fund for the Atlantic Union Conference territory to provide a vehicle for the specific investment of revocable trust funds as provided by the 1977 Annual Council action.

1. The fund will be used to assist in the financing of approved capital improvement projects in churches and institutions in the Atlantic Union Conference. The funds will be developed as a vehicle for the use of specifically invested trusts of which participating organizations are trustees. In such cases the investment of funds may be made by the trustee after receipt of cash from the trustor, or the individual may make the investment directly and then transfer the note as an asset of the trust.
2. The principal amount of the Revolving Fund in the Atlantic Union shall be \$2,000,000.00.
3. The principal obligation of the fund shall be evidenced by 90-day demand or term notes bearing interest at a rate not to exceed 6% per annum. Term notes shall not exceed 20 years from date of issue, and all notes are callable at any time by action of the Union Committee. At the option of the Union, when term notes are issued, a penalty provision may be inserted in the plan covering early withdrawals. Notes are to be issued primarily to members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, and denominational entities and the plan will be promoted only within the Atlantic Union Conference territory.
4. To provide liquidity, a minimum of five per cent of the Revolving Fund shall be invested in short-term investments.
5. The loans shall be evidenced by promissory notes bearing interest at the rate of not less than two per cent more than the maximum interest currently being paid on Union Revolving Fund notes and executed by the borrowing organization. Loans to churches and institutions currently shall bear interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum. Health-care institutions and their affiliates are not eligible to receive loans from the fund.
6. Loans from the Revolving Fund shall be made by the Union only to churches, local conferences, and institutions located within the Union territory and owned and operated by the Union or by its constituent local conferences. In the case of churches and local conference institutions, such notes shall be guaranteed in writing by the local conference concerned and shall be recorded by said local conference as a contingent liability. Applications for loans shall be made on prescribed forms and be approved by the local conference committee for churches and local conference institutions, and by the Union Conference Committee for Union conference institutions. Loans to local churches shall be repayable in monthly installments over a period not to exceed the maximum time provided by policy.

ATLANTIC UNION CONFERENCE REVOLVING LOAN FUND POLICY (Cont.)

7. Loans to churches and other projects will contain provision that the loan is callable on a 90-day notice. In such situations the guaranteeing organization will secure a loan from a commercial lending institution if necessary.

8. Loans shall be made to churches or institutions within a conference only to a maximum limit as determined by the amount of Revolving Fund notes issued to members or organizations within that conference. If any conference is not using the maximum permitted, it may release its "borrowing power" to any other organization.

9. A sinking fund shall be established from 75% of the difference between the interest income and the interest expense of the fund. Records shall be kept to reflect the interest income of each conference in the sinking fund. Interest earned on the sinking fund shall be added to the sinking fund.

10. Loans to the Revolving Fund, and additions and withdrawals therefrom shall be in multiples of \$500.00.

11. Interest on notes shall be paid quarterly. If funds are received by the tenth of any month, interest shall be paid from the first. If funds are withdrawn within six months, interest shall be paid to the end of the previous quarter; after six months, interest will be paid to the end of the preceding month. In the event of the early withdrawal of term notes, interest shall be reduced to the appropriate time rate.

12. Loans to approved projects may be made on a "draw" basis during the course of construction of a project, and payments on all loans shall begin not later than six months following the initial draw. The payment schedule shall be on a monthly basis and shall be due on the first of each month and become delinquent on the tenth of each month. To cover the extra costs of servicing delinquent payments, a "late charge" of five per cent of the payment shall be charged.

13 In the event a loan becomes three months delinquent, the fund may require the guaranteeing organization to pay the loan in full.

14. The conference treasurer shall be designated as the local representative for the fund in each area; however, such duty may be assigned to any other officer of the conference or association. Responsibility of the fund representative will be but not limited to the following:

Coordinating loans to churches.
Servicing Revolving Fund notes.

15. Interest on Revolving Fund notes held by the local conference association as trustee shall be paid to the trustee and not directly to the trustor.
