#### DAVENPORT MATTER LOAN FUND

VOTED, To authorize the General Conference to establish a Davenport Matter Loan Fund to provide temporary assistance to affected denominational entities with cash flow problems arising from the Davenport Matter as follows:

- 1. Entities may borrow from this fund only when other resources are not readily available to cover their cash flow needs.
- 2. Loans from the fund will be requested by the union treasurer on behalf of the union itself or for subsidiary organizations, and the loans will be made to and in the name of the union.
- 3. Funds will be advanced by the General Conference to the union concerned. The General Conference will then immediately charge all the unions in the United States on the basis of the 1981 tithe income 60% of the loan made and the General Conference will provide the remaining 40%. Immediately upon receipt of the billing the unions will remit their portions to the General Conference Treasury.
- 4. Interest will be billed to the borrowing organization (union) at the end of each calendar quarter for the time the funds are borrowed and the rate will be set quarterly by the General Conference Treasury based on the average of the short-term interest rates in effect during the quarter less two percentage points.
- 5. Interest will be paid to the unions and General Conference on funds loaned on a calendar quarter basis at the same rate being charged the borrowing entities, the General Conference sending checks quarterly covering this interest.
- 6. Loaned funds will be repaid by borrowing unions in full or in part as soon as cash flow permits and interest will cease the day the funds reach the General Conference Treasury.
- 7. The unions and General Conference will consider funds provided for this purpose as short-term interest-bearing accounts receivable.
- 8. In allocating the unions' portion of the funds loaned, the following percentages breakdown will be used:
