## Statistical Reports—1926

### Years of Labor and of Progress

MEASURED by results attained during former years, the statistical reports of our Far Eastern Division for the year 1926, appearing in this number of the OUTLOOK, give evidence of substantial gains in many lines.

Various features of denominational statistics for the Far Eastern Division, covering the work of the year 1926, are summed up in Table "O" appearing on pages 8 and 9 (center). These facts are grouped by Unions, the workings and net results for the year in every one of the provincial missions being set forth in detail. In this connection the gains and the percentage of gain during the five-year period of 1921 to 1926 are shown.

#### Church Membership Gains

The gains in church membership for the entire field during 1926 aggregated 2,465, an increase of eighteen per cent., bringing the total number of baptized believers up to 19,472.

For the preceding year, 1925, the net increase in church membership was 2,163. During the five years from Dec. 31, 1921, to Dec. 31, 1926 there was an increase of just one hundred per cent, as evidenced by the following table:

For these advances we thank God, and take courage.

The membership chart given in Table "B" sets forth a number of details for study and reference, including the membership reported in former years.

#### Gains by Individual Unions

The total net gains in church membership during 1926, and during the five-year period 1921-26, have been realized in varying proportion from the ten union missions in our territory, as shown in the "Membership Chart," page 5.

#### Gains by Provincial Missions

In the final analysis, gains in church membership are made in the provincial missions within the various union fields listed; and here again the figures tell many stories of untiring effort and of abundant blessing in some parts of the Division, and of limited results in other parts.

A complete record of the year's showing by provincial missions, and of the status of these provinces five years ago as compared with the close of 1926, is given in table "O" on the two middle pages. This table will bear close study.

#### The Sabbath School Department

A summary of Sabbath school statistics for the Far Eastern Division appears on the upper half of page 4. The total membership, 26,173, is 6,701 in excess of the baptized church membership. This gives ground for large expectations in the winning of many hundreds of the Sabbath school membership as regular members of our churches.

With so many in "the cradle of the church," under constant tutelage in the fundamentals of our faith, we have abundant cause for thanksgiving to God, and for putting forth unceasing effort to bring these Sabbath school students to a full acceptance of the Saviour, and to church fellowship.

The Sabbath school gifts for missions have already reached the substantial sum of more than \$ 29,000 (gold) per annum.

Gains in gifts through the Sabbath schools, and in many other features, are listed in the annual statistics for this department appearing on pages 7 and 8, also on page 4, top.

#### Increases in Tithes and Offerings

The tithes for the year 1926 totaled \$104,974.81 (gold). Year by year, for the past ten years, our tithes have stood as follows:

For our field, during 1926, there was an average tithe of \$6.17 (gold) per member. The average per member in the world, as late as 1897, was \$6.10; but the world average since that date has never dropped as low as our Far East-

ern Division average stands to-day. Efforts are being made to bring up the tithe averages in the various fields.

#### Educational and Young People's Work

One hundred eighty-six schools,—primary, intermediate, academic,—with 401 teachers and 7,065 pupils, bring educational benefits to a considerable portion of our constituency, although less than half of our youth are as yet served thus. The statistics revealing the present status of the schools appear in the two double-page tables shown on pages 6-7 and 8-9. In Table "O" church school statistics are given in the last two columns; on pages 6-7 educational statistics are given in columns 36-48. Young People's Missionary Volunteer statistics are given on pages 6-7 in columns 49-53 also on page 4, lower half. Detailed statistics year by year on educational and missionary volunteer work are given in the last few columns of Tables "F" "G" "H" "J" "K" "M."

#### The Publishing and Home Missionary Departments

For detailed information on the results to date from publishing department activities, see statistical table on page 3. The figures speak for themselves, and give ground for large hope for the immediate future.

#### Progress by Unions

Certain of the statistical tables set forth with considerable detail the progress year by year in various Union fields—Table "G" for Chosen; Table "H" for South China; Table "J" for Malaysia; Table "K" for Manchuria; Table "M" for Philippines; Table "P" for Japan. Owing to the difficulty of segregating statistics for Mandarin China during years when the work was conducted under one central organization, Table "F" has been prepared to show progress year by year throughout all China, including the three outer provinces of Manchuria.

The figures given in Table "J" for Malaysia, Table "M" for the Philippines, Table "K" for Manchuria, Table "P" for Japan, and Table "F" for China, bear silent witness to many steady gains.
