## Statistics



THE real purpose of statistics is to quicken and inspire future effort. Government and business concerns mass the facts of their operations together, not primarily to know what they have accomplished during the period under observation, but that they may discover the weaknesses in the conduct of their affairs and strengthen them. They are also seeking ways and means of making the strong features of their undertakings more effective during the ensuing comparative period. Likewise do the statistical facts in the operation of the church reveal its accomplishments. These figures are intended for only one purpose,—that of stimulating to far greater accomplishments in the cause of righteousness, for this is the work of the church of the living God. Whether the effect of these figures be pleasure or regret, the one object of presenting them is to create in those responsible for them a purpose to make a better showing at the end of the next comparative period. The “short-comings” are to be made “long-comings,” and the “long-comings” are to be made much longer. Statistics are of little value to those for whom they are intended unless they are carefully studied. An interest in what may be done to advance the cause of salvation is created in part by a knowledge of what has been done. The essential facts of a statistical report are gleaned and fixed in mind only by careful study. For a report to effect an improvement and an advance in the work it represents, it must be fixed in the minds of those concerned therewith. Now a report of the work of the church concerns every member of the church. Each must feel himself responsible for the gains or losses in the progress of its work. “We are workers together with God.” While the leaders in our Blessed Cause are most deeply concerned and most responsible for its progress, yet they personally have no more at stake, eternally considered, than has the least known member of the movement. Our work is onward. It is as certain to succeed as that God lives. He has set His hand to accomplish the eternal salvation of every one who will willingly obey his commands of love. It is a glorious thing to be connected with a movement that is growing and cannot possibly fail. “This gospel of the Kingdom shall be preached” is the certain word of its author. “He will finish the work, and cut it short in righteousness.” “Surely I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.” May our accomplishments in 1931 stimulate us to far greater accomplishments in 1932.
