The Statistical Report for 1921

A REPORT SHOWING FIFTY-NINE YEARS OF PROGRESS

In the following pages will be found the fifty-ninth annual statistical report of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination, for the year closing December 31, 1921. Returns were received from all the fields with the exception of the African and Southern Asia Divisions, for which, in the absence of proper data, estimates have again been made, as was necessary in the report for 1920.

Extent of Work

This work is now conducted in 108 countries, by 8 Division Conferences, 51 Union Conferences, comprising 139 local Conferences, and 160 mission fields, operating among a population aggregating 1,425,523,529, and employing 15,000 evangelistic and institutional laborers, who are using in their work 179 languages (publications being issued in 100); and connected with the movement are also 204 institutions, representing, together with conference organizations and church buildings, a total investment (for 1920) of \$30,399,461.49, and an aggregate annual income of over \$23,000,000.

Churches and Members

The number of organized churches now stands at 4,730, an increase of 189 during the year. The membership of churches is 198,088, an increase during 1921 of 12,638. The number baptized during the year was 21,061, an increase of 1,378 over the number baptized during 1920.

In other words, for every \$100 received in 1920, there was received only \$71.77 in 1921.

Exchange of European Currency

From the foregoing it will be observed that the greatest amount of decrease occurs in connection with the European Division. The decrease in this case, however, is apparent and not real, and occurs wholly because of the varying rates of exchange used in preparing the reports for the two years. The amount of money raised in the field and expended in the field did even more work during 1921 than was done during 1920, but the variations in exchange rates resulted in the apparent decrease shown above. The basis of transposition for 1921 is the actual value of the European currency transposed into American currency. As stated before, this method of reporting

funds brings a fictitious result; for when the money is transposed into one standard currency for the world in order to compile this report,—being unable to add dollars, marks, pence, or crowns—the difference in handling the transposition for the two years brings about the apparent discrepancy. The facts are that the value raised in the field in 1921 supported 2,023 laborers as against 1,862 for 1920, and it thus accomplished greater results than for the preceding year, while the figures show a decrease of over two and one half million dollars.

One who is making a study of the tables, comparing this year with preceding years, as contained in the summaries throughout these pages, should have in mind this statement respecting European currency values.

Denominational Institutions

There are now 46 publishing houses and branches, 34 sanitariums, 10 treatment rooms, and 114 educational institutions of advanced grades (1,196 primary), having assets for 1920 of \$14,276,078.97, and employing 7,538 laborers.

The 114 educational institutions had an enrolment of 15,103 students, with 1,110 teachers employed, an average of 13.6 students per teacher. These schools trained and sent into some

branch of the organized work during the year 1,429 persons. The increase in the number of laborers of all classes during 1921 was 1,928, so that the number trained by the schools constituted the largest proportion of those entering the work during the year.

During 1921 the 1,040 persons connected with the publishing work produced the following new literature: 4 periodicals, 83 bound books, 76 pamphlets, 189 tracts, a total of 352 separate publications, the value of one copy of each of which was \$123.06, thus making the total separate publications now stand at 3,507, valued at \$1,000.80. Two new languages were added during the year, Kisukuma, added by the Hamburg Publishing House (Advent-Verlag), and the Navajo, by the Southwestern Junior College. One language, the Java-Malay, was dropped during the year, making the net increase one language, the total now standing at just 100 in which denominational publications are issued.

Denominational Literature

The sale of denominational literature during 1921 aggregated \$4,764,521.06. This literature, issued in 100 languages, is prepared (as indicated in Table 3) in the form of 148 periodicals, 768 bound books, 506 pamphlets, 2,085 tracts, a total of 3,507 separate publications (containing 278,805 pages), one copy of each of which (books in cloth binding) is valued at \$1,000.80.

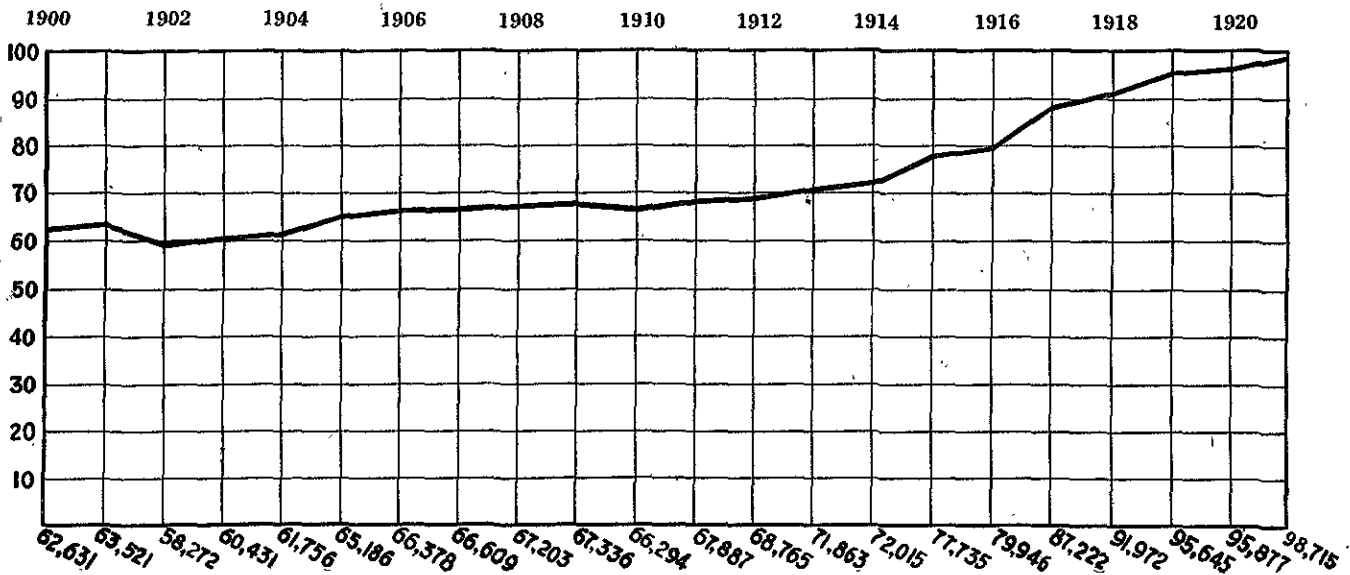

Membership in United States and Canada—1900 to 1921

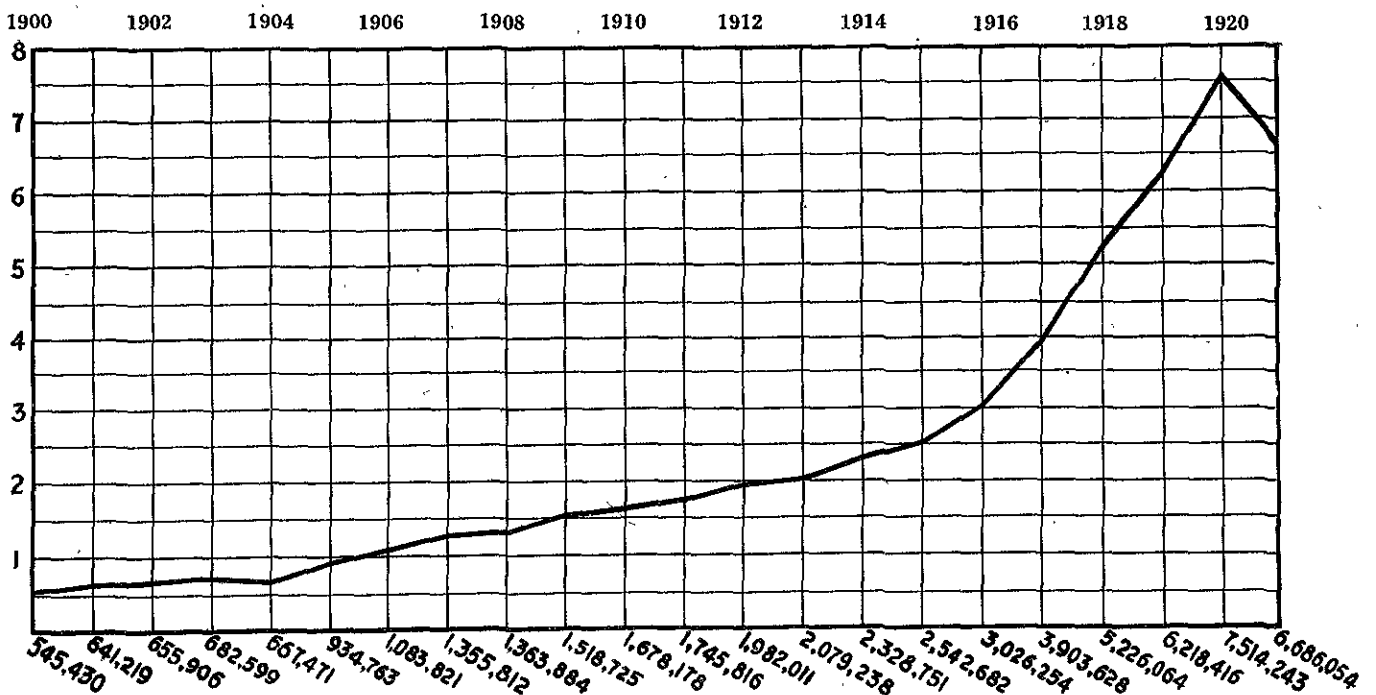

(a) The system of educational work outlined by the Educational Department of the General Conference in 1906, comprising sixteen grades, or years of study, is arranged as follows: Church-schools (information concerning which will be found listed under columns 23 to 27 in Table 1), grades 1-8; intermediate schools, grades 7-10; academies, grades 9-12; colleges, grades 13-16.

(b) In compiling the returns, fractions of acres were not included.

(c) The "capacity" of schools is the number of students that may be accommodated in classes, and does not refer to dormitory or boarding accommodations provided.

(d) The grades taught by each should indicate the kind of work undertaken, as outlined in note (a).

(f) In the column indicating laboratory facilities the word "No" occurs where the schools have none; the word "Yes" is used in connection with schools having such facilities. These facilities cover lines of work in various schools as follows: Astronomy, chemistry, physics, histology, zoology.

Schools having facilities for manual training are indicated by "Yes" in corresponding column; those not having such facilities are listed with "No" opposite. These facilities range as follows: Carpentry, cooking, farming, dairying, nursing,

printing, plumbing, horticulture, dressmaking, tent-making, broom-making, brick-making, etc.

(g) Column 15 shows the total number of graduates from all grades; cols. 16 and 17, the number graduated from grades 12 and 16, respectively.

(h) Column 18 shows the number of students (not graduates alone) entering some department of denominational work during the year.

(m) Studies completed, 297.

(n) Land, buildings, and teachers same as for Arizona Academy.

(o) The North India Boys' School and the North India Chr. Tr. School are conducted on the same property.
