The Statistical Report for 1925

A REPORT SHOWING SIXTY-THREE YEARS OF PROGRESS

In the following pages will be found the sixty-third annual statistical report of the Seventh-day Adventist denomination, for the year 1925. In the case of certain organizations noted in Table 2, the figures for the former year have been inserted because of non-receipt of returns for 1925.

Extent of Work

This work is now conducted in 124 countries, by 8 Division Conferences, 60 Union organizations, comprising 139 local conferences, and 180 mission fields, operating among a population aggregating 1,800,000,000, and employing 17,469 evangelistic and institutional laborers, who are using in their work 252 languages (publications being issued in 128), and connected with the movement are 266 institutions, representing, together with conference organizations and 2,277 church buildings, a total investment (for 1924) of \$44,971,881.12, and an aggregate annual income for both evangelistic and institutional work, of \$33,239,073.44.

Membership

The membership of the 5,629 organized churches December 31, 1925, was 250,988, a net increase during that year of 12,331, or 5.17%. The increase for 1924 was 16,783; for 1923, 13,103; and for 1922, 10,683,—a total net increase during the quadrennial period of 52,900, or 26.71 per cent. The number baptized during 1925 was 25,047; during the quadrennial term, 93,903.

Going back to the third quadrennial session of the General Conference, we find the membership of the denomination as reported at that session, was 98,044; eight years ago the number was reported at 153,857, a gain for the preceding period of 55,813; four years ago the number reported was 193,038, a gain for the preceding period of 44,231; now there is reported 250,988, a gain for the four years of 52,900, a total gain for the three quadrennial periods of 152,944, or 156.00 per cent; in other words, for every member in 1913, there are now two and one-half members.

There are now 9,230 evangelistic laborers, and 8,239 institutional, a total of 17,469, or one active laborer for every 14 members. Of this number 7,512 are in North America, and 9,957 outside this country. The laborers sent into foreign mission service during 1925 was 175; during the quadrennial term, 564, and during the preceding quadrennial term, 708.

The number of laborers reported four years ago was 15,009; eight years ago, 10,554.

Funds

The total tithes and offerings received for evangelistic work during 1925 was \$11,095,347.31, an increase of \$753,786.04 over the receipts for 1924, a gain of 7.29 per cent. This constitutes a per capita of \$44.21 for every member throughout the world. The per capita for the 108,802 members in North America was \$73.37; for all other fields, \$21.89.

At the close of 1925 the total tithes and offerings received since the beginning of this movement aggregated \$118,943,151.62, of which \$89,091,147.68 was contributed from North America, and \$29,852,003.94 from all other countries. Of this grand total there was contributed as tithe \$69,429,979.61; the remainder of \$49,513,172.01 was offerings for home and foreign mission fields.

Offerings to Missions from United States and Canada

The offerings to missions from the membership in North America was \$2,549,050.44, a per capita of \$23.43. Not for the purpose of making an invidious comparison, but simply to state a few facts, compare these figures with those of three of the largest Protestant mission boards operating in North America in behalf of foreign mission fields, and we have the following results: Membership of the three bodies, 7,800,000; Seventh-day Adventists, 1,088,802; (ratio of 72 to 1). Mission fields operated, three bodies, 97; Seventh-day Adventists, 180. Countries in which work is conducted: Three bodies, 79; Seventh-day Adventists, 124. Languages in which work is conducted, three bodies, 166 (including duplication between the bodies); Seventh-day Adventists, 252. Missionaries sent into foreign service during 1925, three bodies, 152; Seventh-day Adventists, from North America, 128; from other countries, 47, a total of 175. Mission offerings per capita, average of three bodies, \$1.25; Seventh-day Adventists, \$23.43 (ratio of 1 to 19). The average contribution to foreign missions from the entire membership of the denomination during 1925 was \$14.03.

Denominational Literature

The sale of denominational literature during 1925 aggregated \$4,631,706.47. This literature, issued in 123 languages, is prepared (see Table 3, page 16) in the form of 177 periodicals, 1,102 bound books, 719 pamphlets, 2,661 tracts, a total of 4,659 separate publications (containing 376,493 pages), one copy of each of which (books in cloth binding) is valued at \$1,417.23.

The total retail value of denominational literature circulated since the organization of this work is \$64,631,168.17,—indicated by decades as follows:

Institutional

The institutions connected with the denomination constitute 53 publishing houses and their branches; operating in 86 buildings, employing 965 persons, and issuing 177 periodicals each year. The total sales of denominational literature for 1925 aggregated \$4,631,706.47, an average of \$18.45 for every member.

The report lists 31 treatment rooms, having total employees of 176, treating 53,712 patients each year; 34 Sanitariums treating 122,030 persons, and employing 3,325 as physicians, nurses, and other helpers.

There are 148 educational institutions employing 1,506 teachers, and having an enrolment of 18,692. The number of students going from these schools at the close of the present school year into some branch of denominational work was 1,584.

The 1,413 primary schools have an additional enrolment of 48,769, so that the total enrolment of both primary and advanced schools is 67,461, a ratio of one student for every 3.72 church members. The enrolment reported four years ago was 42,833 (a ratio of one student for every 4.62 church members); eight years ago, 25,010 (a ratio of one student for every 6.15 church members).




Membership in United States and Canada—1900 to 1925
