At the close of 1939 this work was conducted in 404 countries, islands, and island groups, by 28,900 evangelistic and institutional laborers, who were using 820 languages and modes of speech in their work. This is an increase of 54 languages during 1939. During the last four years the net increase in languages has been: 1936, 71; 1937, 65; 1938, 52; 1939, 54, a total of 242 during the last four years, or one new language added every six days during that period. Literature is now printed in 199 languages.

The membership of the 8,761 churches throughout the world at the close of 1939 stood at 486,670, a net increase during the year of 16,719, or a gain of 3.56 per cent. The increase in membership since the figures presented at the 1936 General Conference session, has been 83,702 members, an increase of 15.06 per cent. This gain is shown by Divisions, as follows:

There are now 69 union conferences, 136 local conferences, 315 missions, and 518 institutions, with which are connected 28,900 evangelistic and institutional laborers. In North America there are 10,608 laborers, and outside this country 18,292, the percentage relation standing for North America 36.71, and outside this country 63.29. The total laborers for 1939 constitutes one laborer for every 16.84 church members. This, however, does not take into account many hundreds of lay workers who are doing efficient work in behalf of this cause.

The net gain in church membership of 16,719 during 1939 has averaged 321 every week, or 46 every day, during the year; while the total contributions received during 1939 were \$13,499,973.10, the largest ever received during any year since this movement was started, averaging \$259,614.87 each week, or \$36,986.22 every day, during the year. The total contributions for all lines of evangelistic work received during the 77 years since the organization of the General Conference in 1863 to the close of 1939, have amounted to the sum of \$279,595,710.51, of which 55.51 per cent has been for tithes; 29.35 per cent for foreign missions, and 15.14 per cent for home missions. The exact amount for each of these items is stated in Summary 8, page 23. These contributions have come from many peoples speaking many different languages. As already stated, the peoples in 404 countries and islands now speak this blessed hope in 820 languages and modes of speech. Literature sales for 1939 were \$4,532,743.77, in 199 languages, the value of one copy of each publication being \$2,570.15. The total value of literature sold during the 77 years since 1863 to the close of 1939 has been \$122,737,422.17.

Some Important Dates Connected With the Rise and Development of the Seventh-day Adventist Denomination

Seventh-day Adventists believe the words of our Saviour as recorded in Matt. 24:14, "And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come." They likewise believe the scripture recorded in Rev. 14:6 which says, "And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people." Believing thus, they are endeavoring to carry this "gospel of the kingdom" to all that dwell on the earth. In the following matter will be found a brief recital of this effort.

The work of William Miller laid the foundation for an acceptance of belief in the second advent of Christ, which is one of the pillars of the Adventist platform. Attention is called to his work, and a brief sketch is given. The dates of important events in the rise of this movement are given in almost consecutive order.

On Sunday, August 7, 1831, William Miller delivered his first lecture on the second advent, in the kitchen at the home of his sister, Mrs. Sylvia Guilford, at Dresden, N.Y.

The first of sixteen articles by William Miller on the second coming of Christ was published in the *Vermont Telegraph*, at Brandon, Vermont, beginning May 15, 1832.

The first pamphlet of sixty-four pages by William Miller was printed at the office of the *Vermont Telegraph*, at Brandon, Vermont, in February or March, 1833.

September 14, 1833, William Miller was granted a license to preach by the Baptist church.

In 1845 William Miller stated that there were 200 ministers in different parts of the United States and Canada, nearly 1,000 Advent congregations had been raised up, and about 50,000 believers.

William Miller died at Low Hampton, N.Y., December 20, 1849, aged 67 years, 10 months, 5 days.

Joshua V. Himes, the publisher of the Advent movement, issued the first number of the *Signs of the Times* on February 28, 1840. He was born May 19, 1805, at Wickford, Rhode Island, and died at Elk Point, South Dakota, July 27, 1895, in his 91st year.

Mrs. Rachel D. Preston, a Seventh-Day Baptist of Verona, New York, introduces the Sabbath among the Adventists at Washington, New Hampshire, and a number of them began its observance "in 1844, after the passing of the time."

The first Adventist to accept the Sabbath truth was William Farnsworth, who said in the little church at Washington, New Hampshire, "As for me, I am going to keep the Sabbath of God's commandment."

Soon T. M. Preble accepted the Sabbath and prepared an article on the subject dated February 13, 1845, written at East Weare, New Hampshire, and printed in the *Hope of Israel* first published at Topsham, Maine, and later at Portland, Maine, February 28, 1845. This matter was rewritten by Elder Preble in March, 1845, and published in tract form. The tract by T. M. Preble caused Joseph Bates to investigate the Sabbath question, and for this purpose he went to Washington, New Hampshire, in March, 1845, and was there settled in his conviction regarding the Sabbath.

The true light on the sanctuary question came to Hiram Edson at Port Gibson, New York, October 23, 1844. He communicated this thought to O. R. L. Crozier who prepared an exposition which was printed in the *Day Star* of Canandaigua, New York, early in 1846, the first article appearing January 24.

"The subject of the sanctuary was the key which unlocked the mystery of the disappointment of 1844. It opened to view a complete system of truth."—Mrs. E. G. White, in "Great Controversy," page 423.

The first tract by Joseph Bates was dated May 8, 1846; the first tract by James White was dated May 30, 1847.

Brother and Sister White "in the autumn of 1846 began to observe the Bible Sabbath, and to teach and defend it."

The first general meeting of Sabbath-keepers was held in the home of S. T. Belden, April 20 and 21, 1848, at Rocky Hill, Conn., with about thirty present.

James White issued the first publication called *Present Truth* at Middletown, Conn., in July, 1849.

Joseph Bates brought out a company at Jackson, Michigan, July 27-30, 1849. They observed the Sabbath first on August 4, 1849, a company of fifteen in all.

At a meeting held in Paris, Maine, September 14, 1849, J. N. Andrews publicly took his stand for the truth.

In November, 1850, the *Second Advent Review and Sabbath Herald* began publication in Paris, Maine.

"Experiences and Views" was first published in August, 1851, at Saratoga Springs, New York.

On August 9, 1852, the first number of the *Youth's Instructor* appeared as a monthly, at Rochester, New York.

J. N. Loughborough took his stand on the truth October 2, 1852.

Uriah Smith observed his first Sabbath in December, 1852. He connected with the Review and Herald office in Rochester, New York, May 3, 1853. This period of fifty years of editorial service was closed at his death, March 6, 1903.

The first meeting place of the few Sabbath-keepers then in Battle Creek and vicinity was in the front room of the house of Brother David Hewitt, on the north side of Van Buren Street, near Cass Street.

The name of S. N. Haskell first appeared in the *Review and Herald* of July 24, 1855.

The Review and Herald was removed from Rochester, N.Y., to Battle Creek, Michigan, and the first number of the paper appeared December 4, 1855.

October 1, 1860, at a conference held in Battle Creek, Michigan, the name Seventh-day Adventist was adopted as the name of the denomination.

Churches were first formally organized in 1861.

On May 3, 1861, the Seventh-day Adventist Publishing Association was incorporated.

The Michigan Conference was the first conference organized, the date being October 5, 1861.

The General Conference was organized May 20-23, 1863, at a meeting held in Battle Creek, Michigan, with 20 delegates, representing six local conferences.

The first church building erected, aside from the church at Washington, New Hampshire, was at Jackson, Michigan, Joseph Bates holding a meeting there March 31-April 2, 1854.

The first tent meeting ever conducted by Seventh-day Adventists was by J. N. Loughborough and M. E. Cornell at Battle Creek, Michigan, June 9-11, 1854.

The first meeting house in Battle Creek, Michigan, was erected early in 1855; the second, in the fall of 1857; the third, in 1866; the fourth, 1878.

In 1865, the first health publication, "How to Live," was published, Mrs. E. G. White, author.

The first denominational health journal bearing the name, *Health Reformer*, was started August 1, 1866.

The Battle Creek Sanitarium (first called Western Health Reform Institute) was opened for patients September 5, 1866. April 9, 1867, articles of association were signed by ten incorporators of the Western Health Reform Institute.

At the sixth session of the General Conference, held in Battle Creek, Michigan, May 12-15, 1868, it was arranged that J. N. Loughborough and D. T. Bourdeau go on a mission to California, and on June 8, 1868, they left Battle Creek, going by way of Panama, reaching San Francisco, California, July 18.

April 11, 1869, there was organized, near Santa Rosa, California, a state meeting with officers and an executive committee was elected.

Joseph Bates died at Battle Creek, Michigan, March 19, 1872, at the age of 79 years, 8 months, 11 days. He was buried in Poplar Hill Cemetery, Monterey, Michigan.

I. D. Van Horn arrived at Walla Walla, Washington, to open work in that section April 8, 1874.

First number of the *Signs of the Times* issued at Oakland, California, June 4, 1874.

First steps taken April 1, 1875, to form the Pacific Press Publishing Association (then called Pacific S.D.A. Publishing Association). Name changed in 1888. The second publishing house, the Pacific Press Publishing Association, was started in Oakland, California, with new equipment in a new building, August 29, 1875.

Beginning in 1867 a small private school was conducted in Battle Creek by Professor G. H. Bell. On June 3, 1872, the school was continued under the supervision of the General Conference Committee. Land was purchased in 1873, and during 1874, a school building was erected. School was opened in the new building, and it was dedicated January 4, 1875.

The Vigilant Missionary Society was organized June 9, 1869, by four sisters, at South Lancaster, Mass. The first State "missionary and tract society" was organized at New Ipswich, New Hampshire, November 6, 1870.

The first missionary to leave this country was J. N. Andrews, who sailed from Boston, Tuesday noon, September 15, 1874, arriving in Neuchatel, Switzerland, October 16. He died at Basel, Switzerland, October 21, 1883, at the age of 54 years, 2 months, 29 days.

D. T. Bourdeau sailed from New York, December 25, 1875, arriving at Neuchatel, Switzerland, January 7, 1876, where he assisted Elder Andrews, later going to labor in France.

The first interest was awakened in present truth by means of literature sent to Scandinavia; this, however, resulted in the calling of a minister, so J. G. Matteson and his wife left Battle Creek, Monday, May 21, 1877. He labored in that country over eleven years.

J. N. Loughborough was selected to open the work in England, reaching Southampton, December 20, 1878. He died April 7, 1924, in St. Helena, California, aged 92 years, 2 months, 11 days. He was an ordained minister 69 years, 9 months, 19 days.

Elder James White died at Battle Creek, Michigan, August 6, 1881, at the age of 60 years and 2 days.

In 1882 the Review and Herald issued the first subscription book, "Thoughts on Daniel and the Revelation," the sale of which was promoted by George A. King, the first copy being sold to D. W. Reavis.

Statistical Report for 1939

The first denominational training school for nurses was opened in the Battle Creek Sanitarium in 1884.

S. N. Haskell, accompanied by a competent corps of workers, reached Sydney, Australia, June 6, 1885, to open up the work in Australia and New Zealand.

The first chapel built in Europe was at Tramelan, Switzerland, and was dedicated by Sister White, December 25, 1886.

The first work in Germany was done by J. N. Andrews, associated with Elder Erzenberger. Later, on January 23, 1886, L. R. Conradi was sent to take up work in that country. During the same year he visited Russia and organized the first church in the Crimea.

J. I. Tay reached Pitcairn Island, October 18, 1886, and remained until November 22, 1886. October 30, Mrs. Mary A. McCoy records: "The Church on Pitcairn Island unanimously kept the seventh day as the Sabbath of the Lord our God,"—twelve days after Brother Tay's arrival.

The first European camp meeting was held in Moss, Norway, in June, 1887.

The establishment of church schools was recommended by the educational society, in 1887.

The first missionaries sent to South Africa were C. L. Boyd and D. A. Robinson, who reached Cape Town, July 28, 1887, accompanied by Carrie Mae (later Mrs. O. O. Farnsworth), Bible worker, and R. S. Anthony and George Burleigh, canvassers.

The National Religious Liberty Association was organized July 21, 1889. Later the name was changed to International Religious Liberty Association, and, in 1901, it was made a department of the General Conference.

Abram La Rue was the first missionary who went to China to labor as a ship missionary, sailing from Oakland, California, December 7, 1887. The first minister to go to China was J. N. Anderson with his wife and his wife's sister, Ida Thompson, who reached Hong Kong, February 2, 1902.

Beginning in 1883 literature was sent to various points in the West Indies and the northern coast of South America. The first minister to go to carry the message to the people was G. G. Rupert, who went at the invitation of the General Conference, reaching British Guiana, January 31, 1887, and organizing a church of 23 members. T. H. Gibbs also responded to the invitation of the General Conference, leaving New Orleans, La., February 16, 1887, for a short trip to Spanish and British Honduras and Bay Islands.

The schooner "Pitcairn" was built during the early part of 1890; was launched, July 28, 1890, after being fitted up at a total cost of \$18,683.05; weighed anchor at 2:45 P.M., October 20, 1890, and reached Pitcairn Island November 25, 1890, on its first cruise.

Mrs. E. G. White and W. C. White, accompanied by a group of workers, landed in Australia in December, 1891.

Two brethren, J. Riffel and a Brother Frick, went from Kansas, in 1888, to Crespo, Argentina, and soon raised up a church, which remained faithful until the living preacher, F. H. Westphal, came to establish the work in Argentina, August 18, 1894.

Healdsburg College was opened April 11, 1882, the second of our denominational schools, with South Lancaster Academy opening its doors April 19, 1882. The fourth college was Union College, which was dedicated September 24, 1891. Walla Walla College opened at Walla Walla, Washington, in 1892. The date of the opening of other schools is given below: Graysville Academy, February 20, 1892; Mt. Vernon Academy, September, 1893; Frederikshavn High School, Denmark, 1894; Keene Industrial School, November 14, 1894; American Medical Missionary College, October 1, 1895.

The party sent to select a mission site reached Bulawayo, Matabeleland, July 5, 1894. The missionaries sent from America—G. B. Tripp, W. H. Anderson, and their families, with Dr. A. S.

Carmichael—reached the mission farm July 26, 1895.—Our first mission established in a heathen country.

K. G. Rudolph and E. L. Sanford reached Appam, Gold Coast, February 22, 1894. On account of sickness, however, it was impossible for them to remain long in the field. For this reason it is not counted as the first heathen country entered.

William Lenker and A. T. Strope reached Madras, India, in 1893, to engage in the canvassing work, thus opening the way for the preaching of the Word. Miss Georgia A. Burrus (later Burgess) reached Calcutta, India, the latter part of 1894. D. A. Robinson and wife reached India in December, 1895, accompanied by Miss May Taylor (later Mrs. W. W. Quantock).

The Hamburg Publishing House was established in Germany in 1895.

W. C. Grainger and T. H. Okohira sailed from San Francisco, California, November 3, 1896, arriving at Yokohama, November 19.

The first number of the *Oriental Watchman* was issued in Calcutta, India, in 1898, W. A. Speer, editor.

R. W. Munson, who had labored for another denomination in the East Indies, accepted the truth and went out as a missionary for this people, reaching Padang, Sumatra, December, 1899.

The buildings of the Battle Creek Sanitarium were destroyed by fire February 18, 1902, and the main building of the Review and Herald, located in Battle Creek, Michigan, was destroyed by fire December 30, 1902. During the same year, Battle Creek College was removed to Berrien Springs, Michigan.

Following the purchase of a mission station in Nyasaland, and the transfer of Joseph Booth to carry on the work, T. H. Branch and family went to that land, arriving at Cholo, August 29, 1902. J. H. Watson and wife reached there June 21, 1903, where he died December 11, 1903, being succeeded by J. C. Rogers and his wife, who reached Cholo, May 23, 1907.

The office of the General Conference was removed to Washington, D.C., Monday, August 10, 1903, and the first number of the *Review and Herald* was printed in Washington, August 20.

December 16, 1903, the Pacific Press Publishing Company issued a "Capital and Labor" number of the *Signs of the Times*. Jasper Wayne of Waukon, Iowa, conceived the idea of selling this paper and turning the proceeds over to the mission funds. This he did for succeeding years until 1908 when the Missions Special of the *Review and Herald* was issued bearing date of November 26, 1908. The amount raised in North America during the latter year was \$14,138.77 and the grand total raised in all the world since that time to the close of 1939 has been \$22,279,755.92.

September 21, 1904, was the date of the first issue of the *Signs of the Times* after the removal of the Pacific Press Publishing Association from Oakland to Mountain View, California.

Elder J. L. McElhaney and wife went out from San Francisco, California, July 16, 1903, for labor in New South Wales, Australia. He spent the time in field work in that conference until March 28, 1906, when he left for Manila, Philippines, arriving April 13, 1906. He remained in the Philippines two years in ministerial work throughout the field, at the close of which he returned to New Zealand, where he labored until 1910, when he returned to the United States, acting first as chaplain of the Boulder Sanitarium, and later, in 1911, as chaplain of the Washington Sanitarium. Then followed various official positions throughout the United States, until May, 1936, when he was elected President of the General Conference, which position he holds at the present time.

From this point let us study the development of this movement, not by separate countries, but taken as a whole, as shown by the Statistical and Financial Statements, arranged by five-year periods, as shown below:
