STATISTICAL REPORT

of Seventh-day Adventist Conferences, Missions, and Institutions in World Field

For the Year Ending December 31, 1950

The statistical record of the year 1950 is indicative of God's continued care and blessing over His work, and we have cause to rejoice at the progress indicated. Church membership increased during the year by 40,174 (5.6%) to 756,712, with overseas membership increasing by 32,428 (6.8%) to 505,773, and North American membership by 7,746 (3.2%) to 250,939. Overseas membership now represents two-thirds of the entire world membership, and North American one-third. Sabbath school membership stood at 952,229, of which three-fourths is overseas.

Church contributions throughout the world field amounted to \$45,908,057.73, including tithe, foreign missions offerings, and contributions for home mission and local church work. This is an increase over 1949 of \$827,157.44, as expressed in U.S. currency. Each member throughout the world field contributed an average contribution amounting to \$73.60 (See note on page 18 relative to tithe and offerings, and to the calculation of per capita giving.)

The tabulations in this report make comparisons over a period of years of church memberships, tithe and other contributions, as well as departmental and institutional activities. Detailed information is presented in tables regarding Seventh-day Adventist conferences and missions around the world; the progress of education, medical and publishing institutions; the countries where Seventh-day Adventist missions are conducted, and the languages in which publications of the church are issued. Summaries indicate the growth of major activities of the denomination since the organization of the General Conference in 1863.

NOTE: While church contributions throughout the world during 1950 increased by \$827,157.44 over 1949, as expressed in U.S. currency, it is to be remembered that in most, if not all, overseas divisions contributions in local currencies have increased to a considerably greater extent than this report would seem to indicate, as adjustments in international monetary exchange rates have affected adversely such exchange calculations. In most instances where this report would appear to indicate a decrease in the tithes and/or offerings of a particular field as expressed in U.S.

currency, there was in fact an increase in local currency actually received. In harmony with the provision of the General Conference Constitution, and commencing with this 1950 statistical report, the calculations of per capita tithes and offerings are based on the average church membership of the four quarters ended September 30, 1949. In future years the basis of such computations will continue to be "the average of the membership of the four consecutive quarters ending on September 30 of the preceding year", as provided for in the Constitution.

FOOTNOTES—TABLE 2, SECTION 1, EDUCATIONAL INSTRUCTIONS

(a) The system of educational work outlined by the Educational Department of the General Conference in 196, comprising sixteen grades or years of study, is arranged as follows: Elementary church schools (information concerning which will be found listed under columns 24 to 28 in Table 1), grades 1-8; intermediate schools, grades 7-10; academies or secondary schools, grades 9-12; colleges, grades 13-16. In schools outside of North America this classification of grades cannot be fully followed owing to differences in educational systems and because training standards are not uniform in all localities.

The College of Medical Evangelists gives a four-year course based on a minimum of three years of college work; and the Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary offers three years of graduate class study above the regular college degree courses.

Part 2 of Section 1—Intermediate Schools—includes some schools doing eleven grades of work and even a few carrying classes in the twelfth grade, but which are not organized as regular academies. Schools with less than ten pupils above the eighth grade are not generally listed, but the number of secondary students in intermediate schools not shown in the detailed report is given in the total designated, "Pupils above eighth grade in Elementary Schools." Only pupils above the eighth grade are considered secondary students.

(b) The "capacity" of schools is the number of students that may be accommodated in classes, and does not refer to dormitory or boarding space provided. Buildings and student capacity of academies connected with colleges are included in the college figures.

(c) The number of pupils in Grades 1-8 in elementary schools connected with colleges, academies and intermediate schools is included in Column 27 of Table 1, and is shown here only for information, and not to be counted again.

The number of teachers in elementary schools connected with colleges and secondary schools is included with other church school teachers in Table 1, column 12, and is not counted in the totals of teachers in Section 4 except where the teacher groups cannot be divided in schools outside of North America, and for these the estimated number of elementary teachers is subtracted from the total.

(d) The grades taught in each school indicate the kind of work undertaken, as outlined in note (a). In North America intermediate schools generally are noted as teaching grades 1-10 or 1-11.

(e) In the column indicating laboratory facilities the word "No" occurs where the schools have none; the word "Yes" is used in connection with schools having such facilities. These facilities cover one or more lines of work in various schools as follows: Astronomy, chemistry, physics, histology, zoology.

Schools having facilities for manual training are indicated by "Yes" in corresponding column; those not having such facilities are listed with "No" opposite. These facilities include one or more of the following: Carpentry, cooking, farming, dairying, nursing, printing, plumbing, horticulture, dress-making, tent-making, broom-making, brick-making, etc.

(f) Column 15 shows the total number of graduates in finishing courses in the academies and colleges. In schools other than some training schools for workers outside of North America no graduates are counted below the twelfth grade. Graduates are for the school year ending in May or June, 1950.

(g) Column 19 gives the number of students (not graduates alone) reported as entering some regular line of denominational work. Students colporteurs selling literature during the vacation period, and persons continuing training in nurses' or medical courses are not considered as definitely entering denominational service at that time.

(h) In 1950 the College of Medical Evangelists graduated 81 students from the medical course, 13 from the dietetics course, and 40 from technicians courses. The Seventh-day Adventist Theological Seminary conferred 48 master's degrees.

(i) A number of students taking classes with the Home Study Institute are also enrolled in regular colleges and academies, and the most of the students studying with the Home Study Institute are carrying only one or two classes each. The Home Study Institute reports 13 instructors doing some teaching for them in 1950 who are connected with other educational institutions, besides the listed faculty members and office staff.

(j) For the past two years the number of nurses in training in sanitarium Schools of Nursing have been included, also the number of nurses graduating.

COUNTRIES, ISLANDS, AND ISLAND GROUPS IN WHICH SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST WORK HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED

The work of Seventh-day Adventists is being carried on in nearly all of the principal countries of the world, and in many of the smaller geographical and political divisions. It is generally considered that a country or political division has been entered by Seventh-day Adventist interests when regular medical, educational, or other mission activities are being conducted among the people of that particular area, or when there is in the territory one or more groups of persons connected in an organized way with the denomination, such as in Sabbath school or in church fellowship. A new field is not considered as entered when only itinerant preaching or colporteur work has been done, or when there are only a few scattered believers.

Recognizing the need of a reliable list of geographical and political divisions which could be used as a basis for checking the different areas in which Seventh-day Adventist work is being carried forward, the following action was taken at the 1946 General Conference session:

"Voted, That the designations of the several sections of the world field in which Seventh-day Adventists are conducting their work be based on the list of countries, islands, and island groups in such authoritative works as the *World Almanac* and the *Statesman's Yearbook*."

Following this procedure, the list shown below comprises the geographical and political divisions given in the *World Almanac* and the *Statesman's Yearbook*.

With world conditions as unsettled as they are at this time, it is not unlikely that political changes may render difficult the maintaining of stable lists of countries for checking purposes. Furthermore, there may be other standard catalogs of countries which should be consulted in addition to those mentioned above. The editor of the STATISTICAL REPORT will welcome any corrections or additions to the lists here presented, substantiated by authoritative sources of information.

Paralleling the standard list of geographical and political areas shown below, there are given the names of the countries, island groups, and islands in which Seventh-day Adventist work is being conducted at the present time, as far as they have been recorded in the General Conference office. This list also is subject to correction by those who are intimately acquainted with conditions in the various sections of the world field; and the list will be extended as new mission territories are entered.
