

Partial Report of Committee

The Committee of nine, appointed to suggest plans, submit the following partial report.

It is recommended, -

1. That a committee of three (Brethren C. H. Jones, O. A. Olsen, and W. C. White) be requested to prepare and present before ^{the} ~~this~~ ^{General Conference} Convention some definite recommendation with reference to providing a central committee of counsel for the ^{legislation} ^{and promotion} guidance of the publishing work as a whole, throughout the world.

2. That the Publishing Houses be encouraged to develop the sale of trade books in their respective fields through the regular trade channels of the world, and that the whole field be considered open territory for this purpose.

3. We recommend that our leading training schools be encouraged to carry on small printing departments in which printing for missionary work should be a special feature.
