VOTED, To distribute this amount as follows:

- 1. To cover the Middle East Division's portion (one-half) of the cost of printing the "Survival Through Faith" tracts, Home Visitation tracts, and the 24 series of tracts in Arabic and Armenian. Estimated cost based on present prices, \$12,500.00.
- 2. To the Nile Union for Elder 0.

 For efforts within the Egypt Mission 5,000.00

 To apply on overdraft on efforts

 conducted in 1952 1,400.00

The East Mediterranean Union has requested permission to build a school building at Basrah, on land for which they are making negotiations. The estimated cost of the building is ID 2,000.000, one thousand of which is now on hand.

VOTED. To authorize the Iraq Mission to erect a school building at Basrah, with the understanding that construction work will not begin until the required amount of money for the building is in hand.

NILE UNION REQUEST FOR PROF. COSSENTINE 675

VOTED, To pass on to the General Conference the request from the Nile Union for the services of Professor Cossentine for a few days on his way back from the Ethiopian Union Mission, to counsel with the Nile Union Committee regarding the new school project.

C. C. MORRIS JORDANIA LOCAL MEETING 676

VOTED, To authorize C. C. Morris to attend a meeting of the Jordania Mission in Amman, beginning January 8, in harmony with the request of the East Mediterranean Union.

MIDDLE EAST DIVISION ASSOCIATION

Consideration has been given to the question of setting up an Association, as a holding organization for the properties within the Middle East Division territory, and it was
