THE DIVISION IDEA.

The Advent Cause is one of orderly growth. Few religious movements, if any, have been planned with such thoughtful method. Under God this is one of the large reasons for its steady, world-wide advance. In our organisation the local church came first and is still the basic form for all worship and endeavour. Early in the Cause churches were organised into conferences, and these again into one General Conference. Years later the General Conference divided itself into districts, which districts soon developed into our present Union Conference plan. Continental and Mission sections or divisions came into existence last. Our world-wide work made them a necessity.

This Division idea, though yet not clearly defined, was given study at the General Conference of 1897. H. P. Holser, the representative from Europe, said then that "our work was gaining such proportions that our General Conference was becoming unwieldy." At that Conference the Foreign Missions, North America, Europe and Australia were recognized as four sections. The Committee on Nominations recommended as President of "the General Conference in America," G. A. Irwin; President of European fields, W. W. Prescott; President of Australasian section, A. G. Daniells. Later the same day "it was moved to substitute the name of O. A. Olsen for that of W. W. Prescott."

At the General Conference in 1901 Sister White dwelt much on the need of reorganisation and a further distribution of responsibility. Speaking of the ideas of some in the past, she said "it was thought that the General Conference should extend over the whole world; but this is not God's order" and further: "this does not mean that we cut ourselves apart from one another and be as separate atoms." "The organisation of new conferences is not to separate us; it is to bind us together."

That same year at a meeting in Friedensau there was "formed the European General Conference" "with a European General Conference Committee" of thirteen members. (These quotations are from the General Conference Bulletins of 1897, 1901 and 1903.)

At the 1913 General Conference, the question of divisions came to the front once more. Division conferences were organised in both North America and Europe. The coming of the War brought in new perplexities, and in 1918 both these Division Conferences were dissolved. Not till 1922 was the Division plan fully developed into its present form. In the second San Francisco Conference each Division was

made a section of the General Conference and granted complete autonomy. A Division Committee in any part of the world is the General Conference Committee at work in that section. In the course of time one Division after another has been organised. At the Darmstadt meeting last August it was voted that the old European Division be dissolved, or rather divided into four divisions. We now have eleven Divisions.

The last meeting of the Division convened at the office in Berne March 19 and 20 this year. There were present: L. R. Conradi, J. C. Raft, A. V. Olson, Guy Dail, W. E. Read, L. L. Caviness, Chr. Pedersen, O. Schildhauer, C. E. Weeks, Steen Rasmussen, W. M. Landeen, W. Müller, H. Böx, Fr. Brennwald and the writer. A number of matters had to be readjusted and worked through, and the finishing work was done. It was a real joy to meet once more. All were of excellent courage in the work before us, each in his own Division. It so happened that Elder L. R. Conradi had his 73rd birthday the last day of this meeting. The Division members present extended to him their best wishes for the years to come, with most cordial thanks for the past. It was also voted that we express our gratitude to the General Conference for the large-hearted and practical support it has rendered Europe during these post-war times.

With this number the "Quarterly Review", or "Statistical Report" as it was first called, is closed. The first number of this paper was printed for the first quarter of 1912. It has appeared continuously since with the exception of a break coming in the years 1915—1919. Brother Guy Dail did much work as editor during the early years, and Brother W. K. Ising has been editor from 1920 up to the present time. We know our readers would wish to express to both of these brethren their sincere appreciation of the faithful work they have done on the paper.

This number contains both the last quarter's and the annual report for 1928. Of this we need not speak in detail. In 1900 there were in the European Division 7082 members. At the close of 1928 this number had increased to 90,631. More than half of this large increase has come since the war. We wish to express our most hearty thanks to every one of our dear fellow-workers and believers who have sacrificed and toiled to make this gratifying result possible. Above all would we thank God for His many mercies over us all these years.

1928 IN THE PUBLISHING DEPARTMENT.

While the year 1928 was a difficult one in many ways for our colporteurs in the European Division, it was also a year of victory and blessings in many of our fields. And strange as it may seem, the greatest progress was made in those fields where economic conditions, poverty, persecution, illiteracy, are the worst. But we are learning more and more that success in God's work is not dependent upon outward conditions and circumstances. While we do not have a complete report as yet from our publishing houses of the European Division, our sales were well over a million dollars. Sales through colporteur channels alone were \$ 784,390.19. But the real success of this work can not be estimated in terms of dollars, marks or pounds, but in souls won to this message. That scores are constantly being won to this message through the literature ministry we have every evidence.

Some time ago one of our French colporteurs expressed his feelings thus: "I have a **terrible courage** these days." We do have a courageous group of colporteurs in Europe today, and God is blessing them.

THE MISSION SPIRIT IN OUR SCHOOLS.

One of the outstanding characteristics of the various student bodies in our schools is the desire to take an active part in all kinds of missionary endeavour. This spirit of service is growing in intensity, at least in some institutions. We have never had a better Harvest Ingathering campaign in our schools than the last one. Teachers and students spent freely of their time to gather for the Lord. Three of the schools set aside several days during the campaign for that work. One institution combed its territory within a radius of 35 miles, employees as well as students joining in the campaign. The cook in one school collected nearly \$ 200, all in small gifts. One student in the same school brought in more than \$ 100, during the campaign.

The same is true of other lines of missionary activity. The canvassing work in our schools is growing apace. Last year, the students in Czechoslovakia, only 27 in number, sold \$ 2,794. worth of literature. The Riga school set a goal of \$ 2,000. for this year. The goal of Stanborough College is \$ 5,000. for the school year. The students in Neandertal are working with all their customary vigour, as are also the student bodies in our other German schools. Regular days are set apart each month for this work. Of course during the summer period, scores and hundreds of our students are out in the colporteur work, earning their scholarships.

The school work in Europe has come to stay. With the hundreds and thousands of Adventist youth

found in every field in Europe, we ought to look forward to a time of great possibilities in our school work.

A RETROSPECT.

As we look back on the progress made by our Sabbath school work during the past four years, we have reason to thank God for his blessing. We must also express our appreciation to all our fellow workers for their faithful cooperation that under God has made such results possible. Our Sabbath school membership at the end of 1924 was 80,121; at the end of 1928 it was 109,228, or an increase of 29,107 in four years. In this same period our baptized church membership increased 15,210; so the increase in Sabbath school membership was almost twice as great. An increase of over seven thousand each year is really wonderful, and we feel to praise God.

During the same time foreign mission offerings given through our Sabbath schools each year have greatly increased. The total Sabbath school offerings for 1924 were \$ 156,211.50, while for the year 1928 they were \$ 200,458.38. This is an increase of \$ 44,246.88 in the amount of the annual Sabbath school offerings, or an average increase of more than eleven thousand dollars each year in these offerings. Again we thank God for the privilege of being associated with such a liberal people. God will reward his faithful servants for the sacrifices which this has meant to them. When we see the souls saved in the kingdom through the efforts of the missionaries that this money has supported, we shall all be fully repaid.

What the Sabbath school during the four years has brought of better knowledge of God's word to the members would be hard to estimate. One can count the offerings given, but none can evaluate the spiritual blessings received through the Sabbath school. Then too where shall we find the means of measuring what the Sabbath school has done during the past four years in training both young and old, workers and church members, for better service for the Master? We trust that our teachers have made progress in the efficiency of their teaching, and that our Sabbath schools are better schools because of the help given during the past four years by our union and local conference Sabbath school secretaries and because of the letters and the Sabbath school papers and other Sabbath school teachers' helps that have gone out to the field.

The record for 1928 is ended, but we still have a portion of 1929 before us. Let us reconsecrate ourselves to greater endeavours for the future in the important branch of God's closing work in our days. To this article we are adding two comparative tables, one of membership and the other of offerings, in order that each one can see just what was the progress made in his own field during the past four years.

DEVELOPMENT OF THE WELFARE WORK IN 1928.

April 1st 1926 the German Welfare work was begun by the undersigned in the Rhineland Conference. In 1927 this department was taken up by the West German Union Conference and was conducted in the same manner as the public welfare organizations. It was soon evident that the needs for the work were more and more apparent and that interest for it was everywhere at hand. Since the latter part of September 1928 the welfare work has been taken up in all Germany under the direction of the three Unions. Heretofore our welfare work has been conducted more in a private way rendering all the assistance we could to those within our own ranks. However,

in order that this work might be organized in such a way as to render real help it seemed best for us in our philanthropic endeavour to cooperate with the public welfare organizations of the country. To bring this about we petitioned to be taken into the Fifth Welfare Union at the beginning of October 1928. Our petition told the purpose and the aim of our work. After we had met with a number of the leaders of these organizations, on November 13th 1928 we were received as the "Abteilung für Wohlfahrtspflege und gesundheitliche Fürsorge der Gemeinschaft der S. T. A. in Deutschland" into the Fifth Welfare Union.

As the Fifth Union is a member of the German Liga for the German welfare work, we are, through it, represented in the German Liga. Furthermore,

by becoming a member of the Fifth Union we have the character of general philanthropic usefulness granted to us and have the same privileges that all the welfare organizations of the country have, and are permitted to exercise the rights of these organizations in our charity work. Because of this we asked of the chief of police in Berlin permission to solicit for the poor in greater Berlin. This permission was granted us and in a short time we were able to secure a number of things, among them: raincoats, cloaks, overcoats, coats, pantaloons, clothing, shoes, dresses, stocking, socks, children's clothing, night-gowns, jumpers, hats, caps, children's shoes, table-cloths, collars, house-shoes, handkerchiefs, shirting, infants' clothes, towels and many remnants.

As our permission to collect was granted for so short a time we petitioned again for an extension

of the time and it seems that this will be granted. This shows the necessity of a thorough organization through which our brethren will be enabled to do a good and great work without it being a personal burden to their own pocket books. From all parts of the country we are now receiving very encouraging reports of the work that has been done and in this way Isaiah 58 is being fulfilled. The blessings of the Lord which accompany such activity are being experienced.

It is very interesting that in this time when the love of many is waxing cold, when there is so much egoism and disregard for the rights of others, that we should develop the virtue of mercy in dealing with our fellow men.

Although not all the work of the first half year in 1928 was public welfare work, and that which

was conducted was without any systematic solicitation of materials from non-Adventists, still there were 6,858 members who had a part in this work of mercy. Because of my connection with the churches and the Conferences in former years, I have been able to instruct our people and to encourage them in this kind of work. We spent 29,538 marks in relief of the poor, 7,599 marks for aid to youth and children, 6,273 marks to help the sick, 3,947 marks for the care of the aged. The sick and poor were provided with clothing in 15,480 cases, 3,478 garments were repaired, 12,592 garments were given away, 3,430 sick were taken care of entirely, 3,593 sick were cared for in the day time, 1,217 sick were cared for during the night. There were 6,851 treatments given, 8,799 half days were given to help in the homes, 109,138 health publications were scattered.

In our Pappelallee Home, Berlin, which was opened in May 1928, 3,815 beds in the first three months were occupied at a small charge, 66 beds were given free, 175 beds were given to the needy and 33 articles were given away. The public welfare officers of Berlin turned over to us 26 persons during these three months.

Since February 1st 1929 we have commenced the care for prisoners in this home and this brings us into contact with the great Berlin Prisoners' Relief Society. In our home we receive prisoners who are set free and give them work and seek to help them to find their way back into regular citizen life.

Thus one can see that the welfare work of our denomination is developing and brings to our people all kinds of possibilities for deeds of philanthropy. It would seem reasonable to suppose that since the

DEVELOPMENT OF OUR MEDICAL MISSIONARY WORK IN GERMANY.

The training centre of our Friedensau nurses until 1917 was the Missionary and Nurses' Training School at Friedensau. However, when Dr. Meyer was called to serve in the army we were obliged to close the place, after it had served as a hospital for the wounded for nearly two years.

In 1919 some of our sisters went to the University Clinic at Halle for further training. As it was now required of them to take the State examination in nursing, they were obliged to attend a training school acknowledged by the State. There is a large number of our sisters who have been trained there during the past ten years and some are in attendance there at the present time.

The institution in Zehlendorf was also bought in 1919 and it was there that a Nurses' Training School was established, which in 1922 received recognition from the State, and in October 1923 the first State examination was held there. As the institution has been extended from time to time, so also has it enlarged its training school, until today there are 17 nurses and 31 probationers.

In 1923 an opportunity presented itself in Rabenstein, near Chemnitz in Saxony. We were

invited to provide the whole nursing force of a district hospital from our own workers, and a Nurses' Training School was established there. This House has also been enlarged, so that today we have there 17 nurses and 23 probationers.

The good reputation of our Rabenstein nurses has caused the chief doctor of one of the neighbouring hospitals — Lichtenstein-Callberg — also to call for our nurses. So at the beginning of this year 12 nurses and 8 probationers went to this hospital, which has also opened a Nurses' Training School.

Some nurses remain in the institute where they have received their training, but most come to the Nurses' Homes, as we have them in eight cities at the present time: Berlin, Breslau, Dresden, Leipzig, Chemnitz, Frankfurt/Main, Wiesbaden and Cologne. An average of 8 to 10 nurses work in these homes.

Since the appointment of our nurses to the Lichtensteiner Hospital, many are taken from our Homes, so there is urgent need for others to fill the vacancies. There is plenty of work in private nursing, especially in winter.

The need for nurses in the Hospitals and Clinics is also great. In these Houses our nurses are in great demand.

In the autumn we hope to receive into our Home a large number of nurses, who have finished their course.

At the present time we have in the "Deutscher Verein für Gesundheitspflege" 130 nurses and 67 probationers. There is yet great need for more and we hope that many young sisters will decide to take up this calling. The great God who has so graciously helped the medical missionary work in Germany will continue His blessing upon it.

NOTES ON THE STATISTICAL REPORT.

This is the last statistical report of the European Division. It is a little later than usual because we wanted to include not only the fourth quarter's and annual reports of the fields, but also those of the institutions, which latter, it will be remembered, have formerly appeared with the first statistics of the following year.

The European Division reaches the end of its history with a membership of 90,631, grouped in 2,645 churches — or 32% of our entire world membership. Its area and population are equal to about one third of the whole world.

Not wishing to add to the already large quantity of figures, I would merely call attention to the

recapitulation on pages 22, 23. Here not only the totals for 1928 are given but also for each of the five preceding years. These figures should be given careful study for they provide much food for thought. It is true there has been a gain from year to year, but there has also been a steady decline in the ratio of increase.

Tithe. We can take courage, however, from the regular rise in tithe receipts, in the per capita rate, as well as the total receipts. Every union shows a gain in tithe for 1928 over 1927. It is an interesting fact that the tithe in the European Division for the last two years amounts to more than that received for the first forty years of our work in Europe (1874—1914).

Total Offerings. Although the total amount of offerings has increased each year, yet the pace has been slower than that of the tithes, as shown below:

Now let us leave what was the old European Division and turn to pages 30, 31 where we have endeavoured to give a picture of its children, the Central, Northern, South European and the Russian Divisions. To the fields given for the Central European Division, the Netherlands East Indies must be added with its 29 churches, 1700 members and 21 European, and 133 native workers.

Coming to the South European Division the reader will look in vain for our good old Latin Union. This has followed the example of the European Division and abdicated in favour of four unions. These are: the Franco-Belgian and Swiss Union Conferences and the Italian and North African Union Missions. The German Swiss Conference, formerly belonging to the Central European Union will now be part of the Swiss Union.

It will be noticed that for the Russian Division no specification by unions is given. This is due to

"At a meeting held Oct. 2, 1792, in connection with the Baptist Missionary Society, an appeal was made for a volunteer to open up work in India. The chairman said, 'It is clear that there is a rich

every human effort. No sacrifice we may make, no hardship we may endure, whatever it may be, is too great for its accomplishment.

"To love as Jesus loves: When we have opened the heart's door in answer to the Saviour's knock, and the Saviour with His everlasting love of eternity has come into our hearts, then we shall be able to love as He loves. And this is just the experience that Jesus longs for us to have. The great heart of Jesus is an abiding place of the love of Him who 'so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son.' Christ's prayer to God, 'I in them and Thou in Me', is a promise to us that we may have Jesus in our hearts, and God's love being in the heart of Jesus, it will thus be in our hearts, and from it the issues of our life will flow.

"To work as Christ works: It is said that He went about doing good; that He spent His time

between the mountain and the multitude; that whole nights were spent in prayer for those to whom He ministered; that to do His Father's will was His meat and drink; that He divided His food with the hungry, gave the cup of cold water to the thirsty, laid His hand on the fevered brow, and took little children in His arms and blessed them. He loved the bad as well as the good. And while to the hypocrites and despisers of His grace He spoke the most scathing rebukes that ever fell from human lips, 'there are tears in His voice as He uttered' the words.

"The very best methods, facilities, and plans for winning souls, and even success itself, depend on these three fundamentals, — to be like Jesus, to love as Jesus loves, and to work as Jesus works."
